SYLLABUS: In this course, students will develop the ability to perform microscopic diagnosis of oral and maxillofacial lesions, with emphasis on odontogenic and non-odontogenic cysts and tumors, as well as fibro-osseous lesions of the mouth and maxillary bones. Discussions and presentation of clinical cases will be conducted, addressing the etiopathogenesis, clinicopathological characteristics, differential diagnoses, and treatment of each condition. Special emphasis will be placed on the etiopathogenesis and manifestations of cysts and fibro-osseous lesions.				
OBJECTIVES: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understand the clinical and pathological aspects of the most common oral diseases and oral manifestations of systemic diseases, with emphasis on odontogenic and non-odontogenic cysts, and fibro-osseous lesions of the jaws;• Discuss key concepts in microscopy and laboratory tests, such as immunohistochemistry and in situ hybridization, as well as molecular biology concepts relevant to the diagnosis of the lesions covered in the discipline.
